- ➤ Appreciated organisation of One Day National Seminar on "Gender and Violence: Structure, Power and Resistance (The Context of North Western India)" sponsored by ICCSR (NWRC) by Department of Sociology on 3rd February, 2016. Paucity of funds is issue to be tackled in order to make such efforts more fruitful.
