College Profile

Guru Gobind Singh College for Women was established by the Sikh Educational Society in the year 1973, with the primary aim of imparting quality education to young women, so that they feel empowered to face the changing world. The mainstay of the institution has been to prepare students to lead a wholesome life, by nurturing in them the human qualities as well as the abilities to emerge as smart, confident, strong, informed and responsible citizens of the globalized world. Driven by the teachings of the Sikh gurus, the College has been progressing steadfastly towards realizing its mission of creating balanced minds wherein knowledge is teamed with ethical thinking. Ranked as one of the pre-eminent institutions of the region, the College is located in the prime area of Sector 26, Chandigarh. The spirit of the College is embedded in its motto, SHUBH KARMAN TE KABHUN NA TARON, implying 'Never to stray from the path of righteousness.' Catering to the all round development of its students, the College fosters in the young minds the spirit of healthy nationalism, social responsibility, moral uprightness, feelings of compassion and love, care for environment, and above all a life of service and sacrifice as exemplified by Guru Gobind Singh Ji.

MANAGEMENT

The College is privileged to be governed by a duly constituted and elected body, the Sikh Educational Society (SES), Chandigarh. Formed with a vision to modernize the educational, cultural and social environment of the region, SES comprises of eminent bureaucrats, philanthropists, scholars, prominent educationists and administrators. Presently, the SES is headed by S Gurdev Singh Brar, IAS (Retd), President, SES; S Kulbir Singh, Chief Engineer (Retd), Vice President SES; Col (Retd) Jasmer Singh Bala, Secretary, SES and S Karandeep Singh Cheema, Joint Secretary, SES. The varied experience and constant encouragement of members of the SES contributes tremendously towards the growth of the College.

ACADEMIC COURSES

Affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh, the College offers Graduate and Post Graduate courses in Arts, Commerce, Computer Science and Applications and Science. A total number of 1951 students were enrolled in the current session in different programmes of study. Science has been introduced in the College from the 2015-16 session. The first batch of BSc (Non Medical & Computer Science) started with a total of 73 students in three Departments; Departments of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. This academic session also saw the

successful introduction of Masters in Economics and the Second year of Masters in Sociology. Apart from M Com and M Sc (IT), Post Graduation in English has been running for the last four years. This year elective subject of Functional English was introduced in BA III.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The 11 acre sprawling campus is replete with an expanse of infrastructure which includes all the latest facilities, well-equipped labs, air conditioned well-stocked library, Mata Kheevi Hostel, Seminar Room, Mata Ganga Auditorium, Cyber Cafe, Mata Gujri Fitness Centre, Student's Centre, expansive grounds, etc. A Language Lab for Functional English was set up with state-of-the-art equipment and facilities. The Lab is well-stocked with Language Skills Software for the benefit of students. In 2015-16, the College saw the addition of Laboratories in Physics and Chemistry. These Labs boast of latest equipment and resources for the newly introduced BSc course. The College ensures that learning resources are made available to the students to develop their proficiency in academics. Advanced learners are provided with extra reference books/ material by the teachers who set suitable goals before them so that the students feel adequately challenged. The Student's Centre is housed with Stationery Shop, Photostat Facility, and Student Council Office. Also located in the College is a fully functional SBI Branch exclusively for the benefit of students and College employees. Lending a panoramic view, the landscape garden set near the main building with smooth lawns and beds of perennials has augmented the beauty of the campus. Providing the right ambience for the young scholars to bloom in the perfect environment, the College campus has won the 1st prize at the Annual Rose Festival 2016 in the category of the 'Best Maintained Campus' in Chandigarh, a feat which the College has been consistently accomplishing since 2008.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

The College library has a double storey- building with the spacious modern infrastructure. The Library provides an Open Access system. It is an ideal place for the users to expand and widen their knowledge in a comfortable environment. Well stocked with approximately 21300 books and 412 CDs on different subjects, the collection is enriched with reference books, coffee table books, light reading books like fiction, self help, biographies of eminent personalities, etc. A total of 45 Magazines & Journals as well as 19 Newspapers are also subscribed by the library on annual basis. There is a separate Section Book Bank consisting of nearly 1170 books on different subjects which are lent out for the full session to the needy as well as the meritorious students. To display the fresh arrivals, there is a Display Stand in the Library.

Library is fully automated with LibSys Software and is provided with OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) facility, through which the users can search their required documents without any intermediary help. The most striking feature of the library is Learning Resource Centre, on the first floor, where students have added facilities for their research oriented activities. Ten computers have been installed in this Section with internet facility. We have subscribed e- Journals under the scheme of N- LIST Programme of INFLIBNET, UGC. There are separate Reading Rooms for students to read their personal documents/ books.

As members of the Chandigarh Librarian's Consortium and Panjab University Book Club, the College avails the benefit of accessing the latest Publications of the Universities. The Library organises various workshops and related activities throughout the year to inculcate the quest for knowledge in the students.

COLLEGE HOSTEL

The College has a well-equipped Hostel offering accommodation to 350 residents and catering to four SES institutions. There is a Gurudwara Sahib within the Hostel premises, which offers sanctum to students. Periodic renovation of the Hostel is undertaken to ensure good comfort and hygiene levels to the residents. Facilities like laundry, Common Room, Visitors' Room and LCDs are provided.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND CONCESSIONS

The students of the College are constantly motivated for attaining excellence in the University examinations through various incentive schemes such as scholarships, fee concessions, Roll of Honour and prizes. To stir and motivate the weaker students, the College provides remedial classes. Students from socially and economically weaker Sections are given financial aid, which subsequently leads to their academic growth. The College grants various scholarships to the students on need-cum-merit basis. Scholarships are received from other sources as well, such as Directorate of Higher Education, UT Chandigarh, Sita Ram Jindal Foundation, New Delhi, Guru Harkrishan Educational Society, Chandigarh, College Development Council, Panjab University, Chandigarh, District Welfare Office, Kaithal, Haryana, Directorate of Social Welfare, Jammu & Kashmir, Life Insurance of India Scholarships, Directorate of Social Welfare, Manipur. During the last session, the College received an amount of Rs.509130/- from above mentioned sources. The College also granted scholarships worth Rs. 35000/- to the students on need-cum-merit basis to ensure equal opportunities to all Sections of students. Besides these, several philanthropists also contribute towards the education of the girl child through the College machinery.
