Academic Courses

Affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh, the College offers Graduate and Post-Graduate courses in Arts, Commerce, Computer Science and Applications and Science. A total number of 2039 students were enrolled in the current session for different programmes of study.

Infrastructure

The 11 acres of sprawling campus is replete with an expanse of infrastructure which includes the latest facilities with three-storeyed Arts, Science and Commerce Blocks with spacious and well-equipped Classrooms and Smart Classrooms. A ramp connects all blocks to the ground floor offering easy access to physically disabled.

The College has well-equipped laboratories in the Departments of Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Functional English, Psychology, Home Science, Music, and Fine Arts.

The College library is spacious, fully automated with Campus Whizz ERP software, centrally air-conditioned, equipped with INFLIBNET data base. Learning Resource Centre provides facility to students for their research-oriented activities. The library also has a Braille Corner with NVDA (Non-Visual Digital Access) software for visually challenged students.

The College houses a Research Lab., an air-conditioned Seminar Room, and Mata Ganga Auditorium.

The College boasts of a large sports ground with multipurpose track, Mata Gujri Fitness Centre, an open air gym and expansive grounds for students.

The Students' Centre is housed with Canteen-cum-Cafeteria, a Stationery Shop along with Photostat Facility.

Also located in the College is a fully functional SBI Branch exclusively for the benefit of students and College employees.

The College takes pride in its landscape gardens set near the main building with smooth lawns and beds of perennials which constantly augment the beauty of the campus. The College has Campus-wide Wi-Fi Facility, 24x7 CCTV Surveillance and 24x7 Power Supply and Generator Facility.

The College campus won the 1st prize at the Annual Rose Festival 2022 in the category of the 'Best Maintained Campus' in Chandigarh, a feat which the College has been consistently accomplishing since 2008.



College Library

For almost 50 years, the College has been providing quality education to the students and made continuous efforts to build and enhance its infrastructure in order to facilitate effective teaching-learning practices. The library with modern infrastructure is efficiently handled by Ms. Sukhdeep Kaur, Librarian who along with her young enthusiastic staff is working towards the smooth functioning of the library.

The College Library has a Blog (ggscwlibrary.blogspot.in), a digital space for students to access question papers from previous years, pages/links of various activities and achievements of the staff and students, Newspapers clippings, latest Panjab University syllabus, and links to various open access e-resources. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the library initiated **Gyankosh: an Institutional repository**, where the faculty members contributed their recorded e-lectures in the form of PPTs, audio/video lectures and PDFs, accessible through the Blog. The library provides an Open Access system, making it an ideal place for the users to expand and widen their knowledge. Well stocked with more than **24,300 books and 490+ CDs** on different subjects, the collection is enriched with Reference Books, Coffee Table Books, Light Reading Books like Fiction, Self-help, Biographies of eminent personalities, etc. Total numbers of 9 magazines and Journals as well as 6 Newspapers are also subscribed by the library on annual basis. Library homes a **Book Bank** that Consists of more than 1800 books on different subjects which are

lent out for the full session to the needy as well as meritorious students. To display the fresh arrivals, there is a display stand in the Library and An LED for highlighting the services of Library along with the new arrivals.

KHOJ: The Wall Magazine showcases the creative works of the students as well as the activities undertaken undertaken by various departments of the College the departments.

Library is fully automated with Campus Whizz ERP software. A striking feature of the library is **Learning Resource Centre** on the first floor, specifically focused on facilitating students in their research-oriented activities. The library also has a **Braille Corner**, where one computer with NVDA (Non-Visual Digital Access) software for visually-impaired is installed. The college undertakes subscription of many e-Journals under the scheme of NLIST programme of INFLIBNET, UGC. There is a separate reading room for students to read their personal documents/books. Each Year the students enrolled in the College are oriented towards Library services and facilities.



Department of Commerce





Student Welfare Society

The office of the Dean, Student Welfare constantly strives for the development and welfare of the students. The society endeavours to bring in new efforts and platforms for the holistic development of the students. It provides abundant openings and facilities for the overall growth of personality and leadership skills among the students. In addition, it promotes the effective participation of students in games & sports, cultural and literary activities etc.

- The Student Welfare Society organised an Online Workshop on **“Psycho Social Support for COVID Pandemic Conditions”** in collaboration with Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Government of India on June 5, 2021. Mr Samarth Sharma conducted an interactive session about the role of psycho social support service cell and NGOs during the pandemic conditions. He further shared tips on how to provide relief and support to others and become active citizens of the society.
- On September 6, 2021, an Orientation Programme was held through offline/online mode for students. They were informed about the college rules and infrastructure as well as COVID protocols.
- To mark **Communal Harmony Campaign Week**, the society in collaboration with National Foundation for Communal Harmony, distributed stickers on November 25, 2021 to highlight the importance of communal harmony in our society. Pamphlets were also distributed and displayed on the notice boards.
- On March 8, 2022 students participated in “Cyber Swacchta Mission” a historic chain to signify the cause of cyber security for women, to mark World Women’s Day. 109 volunteers assembled near the College roundabout carrying banners to create awareness for the same.
- On April 1, 2022, students of the College participated in **“Pariksha Pe Charcha”** where the Hon’ble Prime Minister Shri





Narendra Modi interacted with students to share valuable tips on how to attempt exams in a relaxed and stress-free manner.

- A Cyber Swachhta Awareness Session was held in the campus on April 28, 2022 to initiate the formation of **Cyber Swachhhta Yuva Club**, under the aegis of Digital India, the flagship program of Government of India to promote cyber hygiene among masses through youth engagement. Students were informed about the club and the internship programme.
- In collaboration with an NGO, **Open Eyes Foundation**, the students distributed soaps and hygiene products to the needy in Manimajra area on May 08, 2022. Faculty members and students contributed generously for this worthy cause.
- On April 21, 2022, a **free Eye and Dental Check-up** was organised in the College Campus, in association with Super Specialty Hospital, Sohana for

the students, faculty and staff. Specialist doctors examined around 200 students and staff and also made them aware of dental hygiene and care of eyes.

Electoral literacy Club

Electoral literacy Club was established in 2017 on the instructions of Government of India. Under it's aegis College students are made aware of the importance of voter card, making of new voter cards was facilitated. Voter awareness camps are also held in campus. The club coordinators Ms Suparna Randhawa and Dr Jasneet Kaur work towards highlighting the importance of voting rights in functioning of democracy.

National Voter Day was celebrated on January 25, 2022 during which an insta- reel making competition was held.

Placement Cell

The Placement Cell of the College operates round the year to facilitate job opportunities as well as internships to the final year students of the College. It serves as an interface between the Students and the Corporates. Companies are invited from various fields in order to make range of opportunities available for the students of all courses.

The Placement Cell has had fruitful year of placements and internships as several companies visited the campus for the recruitment drive.



During 2021-22, 8 companies visited Guru Gobind Singh College for Women for placements which included UCodeSoft Solutions Pvt Ltd, HIM Technology Pvt. Ltd, Touchstone Educational LLP, Decathlon Sports Pvt Ltd, EGYIOK (All agri on line Pvt. Ltd), Anviam Solutions Pvt. Ltd, NYX Software Design Pvt. Ltd and Piramal Capital and Housing Finance.

In the session around 80 students have been placed and around 30 students selected for the internship with various companies.

- The Cell organised a placement drive on March 12, 2022 in which HIM Technology Pvt. Ltd. conducted two rounds of recruitment process such as aptitude test and personal interview for the role of Cloud Sales Manager and Cloud Architect. Around 15 students participated in this process and 4 were finally selected and given offer letters.
- On March 16, 2022 another drive was organised by the cell in which Anviam Solutions Pvt. Ltd. visited and conducted Aptitude test, Group discussion and final round of Personal Interview. As many as 168 students participated in different rounds and finally 7 students were selected for the role of Business Development Executive and Quality Analyst by the company.

- In another placement drive, two companies were invited, Egiyok (All Agri Online Pvt. Ltd.) and Touchstone Educational LLP on April 13, 2022 to conduct the selection process for different vacancies in respective companies. Egiyok (All Agri Online Pvt. Ltd.) performed different rounds of selection process for the role of Freight Broker in the company. 69 students participated and 13 were finally selected and given offer letters. Touchstone Educational LLP conducted rounds of selection for Language Trainers and Counselors for their company, around 41 students participated and 7 were selected for the same.

Both the companies conducted interview for the selection of interns and visited the campus on May 4, 2022. The HR team of Egiyok company interviewed and selected 20 PG students for internship. Whereas, Touchstone Educational LLP interviewed and selected 6 students for Internship.

- Decathlon Sports Pvt. Ltd. visited the campus on May 5, 2022. They conducted aptitude test, Group discussion and then Personal Interview rounds. 50 final year students participated in the placement drive out of which 6 were selected by the



company and offer letters were given to them.

- The cell organised pre-placement drive with Piramal Capital and Housing Finance company in the month of April to make the students aware regarding the process of recruitment. They were given a link for online psychometric test which was the prior requirement for selection in the company. As many as 150 students appeared for the test and 54 students qualified the same. In the final round, the company visited the campus on May 06, 2022 for personal interview and selected 44 students from different streams, on the spot offer letters were given to them. Most of the students got posting in/ around their home towns.

NYX Software Design Pvt. Ltd. interviewed the pass out students and selected one student as HR of the company with 3.20 Lakh package and a laptop for official work.

In addition to this, two **MoUs have been signed with renowned companies/ organizations**. NYX Software Design Pvt. Ltd. has signed MoU with College on April 19, 2022 and Regional Centre for Entrepreneurship Development (RCED) on May 9, 2022.

The Cell also organizes Seminars/ Webinars to equip students with career guidance and to enhance their employability skills.

- A webinar was organised on October 18, 2021 on **'Financial Markets: Concepts, Operations and Career Guidance'**. Eminent speaker for the session was Sri Harsha, MD, Shine Projects (certified stock market analyst). The Speaker made the students equipped with the opportunities available in stock market and guided them about how to avail them.
- Another webinar was conducted on October 27, 2021 for final year students of all streams on **'Career Counselling for Future Readiness'**. The worthy speaker Mr. Mayank Aggarwal, Verbal,

Hitbullseye guided the students with career opportunities and to make them future ready to be easily absorbed in the market as per their interest/skills.



- The cell organised an **Expert Talk** on 'Skill, Entrepreneurship and Employability: Challenges and Opportunities' on August 3, 2021. An eminent speaker, Prof. Umesh Kalra, ICFAI Business School, Gurgaon apprised students of the current situation in India regarding Employment and Entrepreneurship opportunities. He also guided students to get skill, re-skill and up-skill. He also stressed on women entrepreneurship and the schemes of the government to support them.
- A webinar was organised by the cell on November 23, 2021 based on **'Soft Skills and Resume Writing'** to help the students with these skills so as to be more presentable while interacting with the companies in practical world. 
IQAC

A nodal agency of the institution for initiating and coordinating quality related issues, the IQAC has been instrumental in institutionalizing the quality assurance strategies and processes. Following are the activities undertaken by IQAC during the session:-


A grant of Rs 32,000/- was sanctioned by the Department of Environment, Chandigarh Administration. Under which different activities were organised such as:


