Should conduct mock interview sessions.

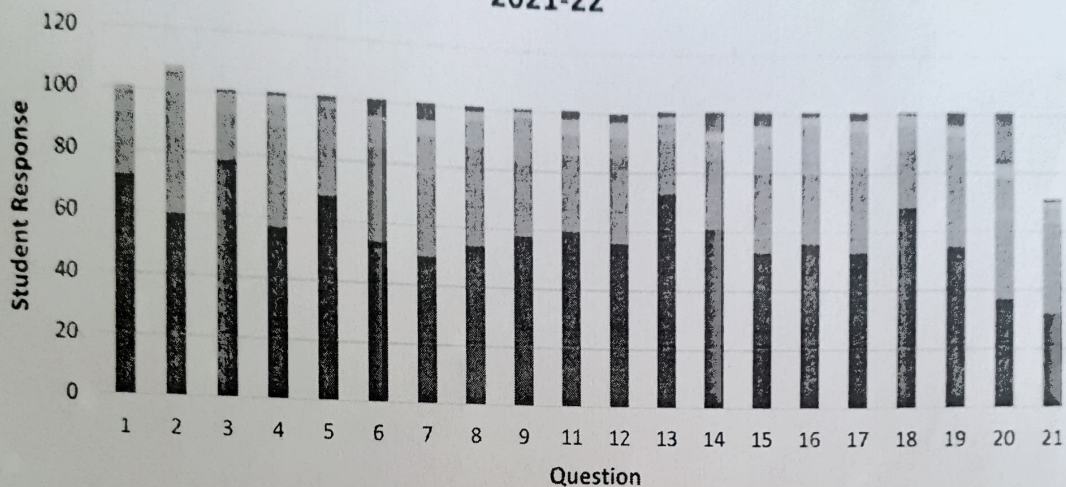
Conduct group activities for the students for role play, model making, assignments, projects, outdoor activities, etc.

To assess the Student Satisfaction on overall institutional performance for the academic year 2021-22, a questionnaire on various aspects like curriculum, teaching-learning processes, and internal evaluation was circulated among the students. A 5-point likert scale was used to take responses. More than 80% students agreed that teachers come well prepared for the class and cover the syllabus on time.
